




The dimensional stability (resistance to swelling and shrinking) of Accoya wood exceeds that of all commonly used wood species, including teak, sapele and iroko.
Accoya wood has been tested for extended periods in all weathers - above ground, in the ground and even in water. These tests have proven that it withstands even the harshest conditions.


Independent testing shows that Accoya has low rates of warping and shrinkage, unlike other commonly used woods.





Accoya is suitable for coverings which, thanks to its dimensional stability, have a much longer lifespan and require less maintenance than other typical wood species.

Below; coatings manufacturer TEKNOS compared coatings on different wood species in a 10-year trial. Accoya coatings are significantly better than those of other wood species.





The durability (resistance to rot) of Accoya wood is Class 1, exceeding commonly used cladding woods such as Western Red Cedar, Larch, Douglas, tropical hardwoods and thermally modified woods. Each batch of Accoya wood is analyzed in the laboratory after production to guarantee its performance.

Accoya wood is subject to external conditions. All materials exposed to external conditions are degraded through a series of chemical, biological and physical processes.

The surface of all wood is attacked by a combination of UV, non-wood fungi, algae, mold, yeast and pollution.
Untreated Accoya wood will age a beautiful silver gray over time (depending on location and weather conditions).
